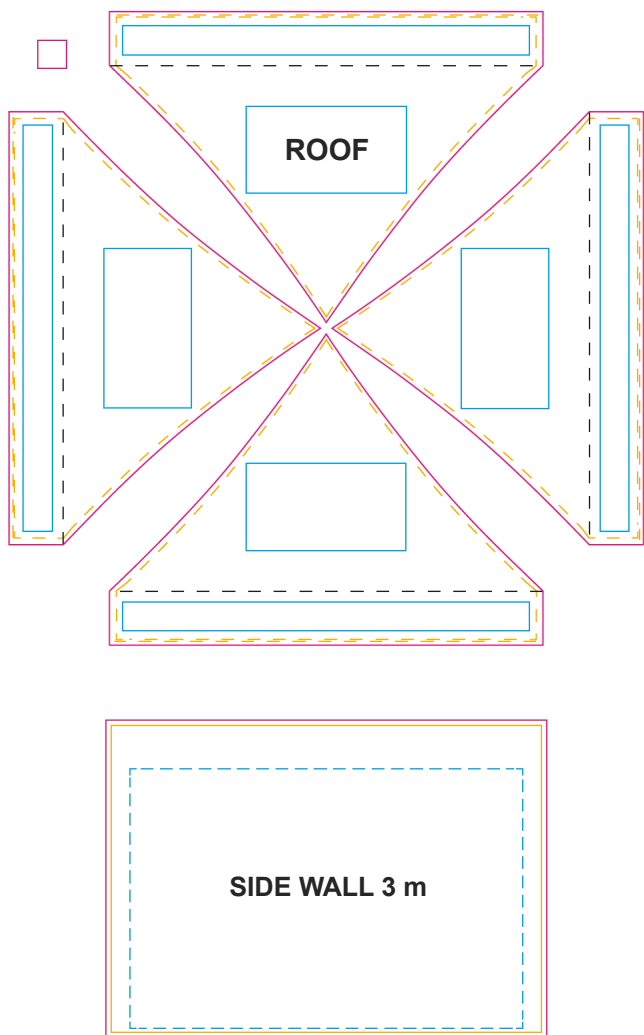

Print format

Extend the background and graphics to the edge of the print format.

Visible finished format

The area visible after sewing and finishing.

Safe area

Place important logos, text and graphics within this area.

- Prepare your design in the 1:1 print template from the product page. Before saving the print-ready PDF, be sure to remove all guide lines and template elements.
- The templates are set up at 1:1 scale. Required resolution: 100 dpi.



Print file guidelines

File formats

Please send print-ready PDF files or open files from graphics software. We accept Adobe InDesign, Illustrator and Photoshop files as well as PDF and EPS files.

Files from Word, PowerPoint, Excel and MS Publisher, and PDFs exported from these programs, are not suitable for print.

Page format and resolution

Set up the file at 1:1, 1:2 or 1:10 scale. At 1:2 or 1:10 the resolution must be correspondingly higher (2x for 1:2, 10x for 1:10). Check the quality of the print PDF at 100% view in Acrobat (200% for 1:2, 1000% for 1:10).

Crop marks

If you add crop marks, place them outside the bleed.

Fonts

Embed all fonts used or convert text to outlines. Do not use type with a cap height below 1 cm, as the text may become illegible.

Colours

All files must be set up in the CMYK colour space. RGB data and spot colours are converted to CMYK using the "Coated FOGRA39 (ISO 12647-2:2004)" profile, which may cause colour deviations. Spot colours (HKS, Pantone...) can only be simulated, although a close match is possible. State your Pantone/HKS colours or enclose a proof. On request we can produce a test print for an additional charge.

For a rich black on large areas we recommend underlaying black with cyan, magenta and yellow, e.g.: C=50 M=50 Y=50 K=100.
